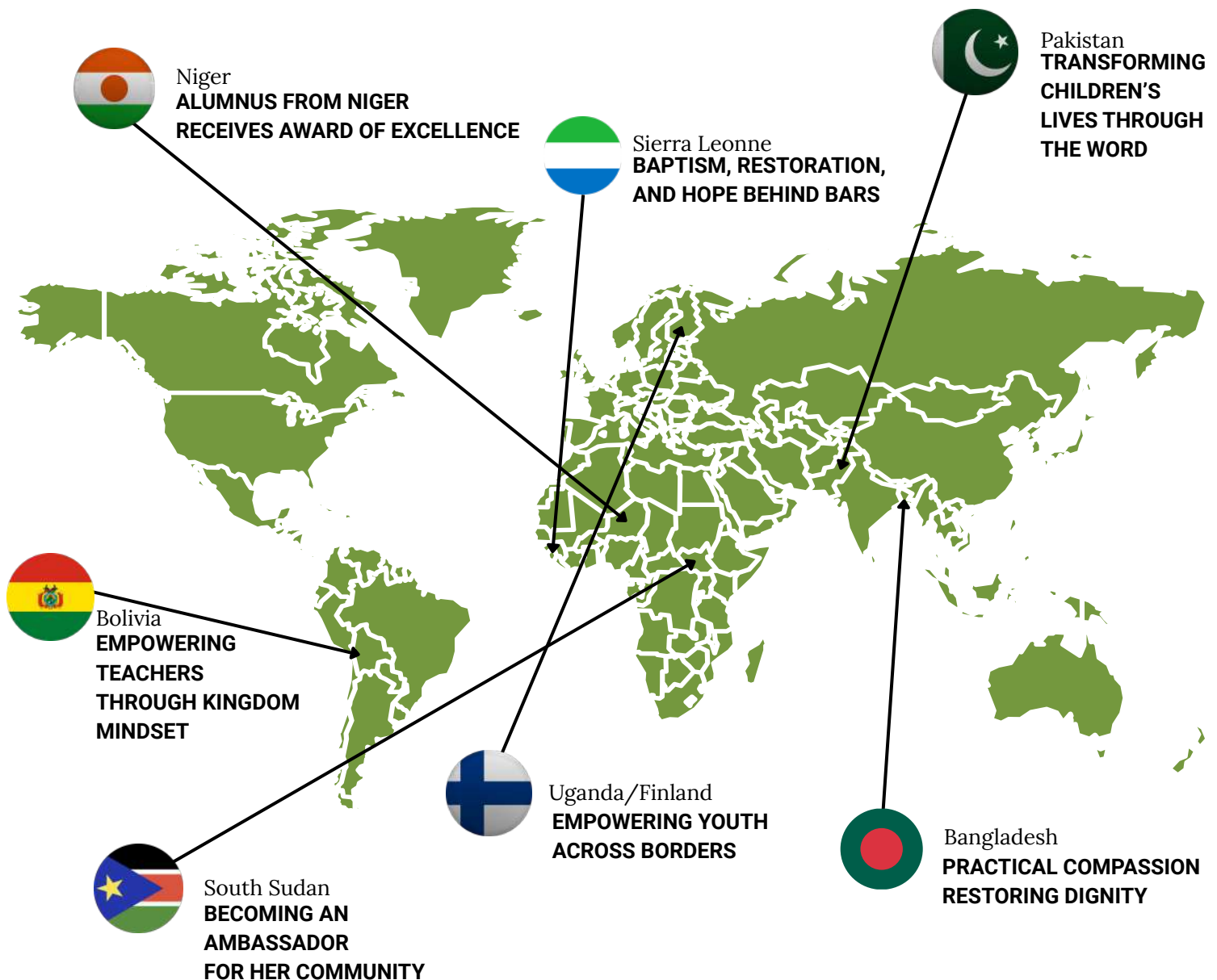
Roots 2026: Update

Baptism, restoration, and hope behind bars



Sierra
Leone

A 2010 ALICT alumnus from Sierra Leone helped facilitate a three-day baptism programme at Mafanta Prison. During the programme, 79 inmates who had previously come to Christ through prison outreaches were baptised, after completing the baptismal programme. In addition, 62 inmates gave their lives to Christ during the programme and have enlisted for the next baptism programme.



The programme featured dynamic preaching, worship, and prayer sessions, creating an atmosphere of hope and transformation. Inmates were receptive and engaged throughout, with many responding to altar calls and seeking spiritual guidance from the team.

ALUMNUS FROM NIGER RECEIVES AWARD OF EXCELLENCE

A 2023 ALICT alumnus from Niger received an Award of Excellence for his leadership as a Leadership Coordinator at a Major International Leadership Conference in Nairobi, Kenya. He was honoured with an award for his "outstanding efforts towards achieving transformation in Africa."

Sudan

A 2025 cohort alumna was recently crowned Miss Heritage South Sudan. As an ambassador for her community, she serves as a spokesperson and promotes unity through her platform. She will soon be launching a leadership training programme for schoolchildren, helping students grow in confidence, develop eloquence, strengthen their public speaking skills, and sharpen their talents.

"This platform gives me access and influence but the real impact will happen in classrooms, in conversations, and in mentorship moments. I want young people, both boys and girls to discover that their voice matters, their culture matters, and their leadership begins now, not later. For me, the crown is not the destination it is a doorway. And I intend to use it to build confident, articulate, purpose-driven young leaders," she said.

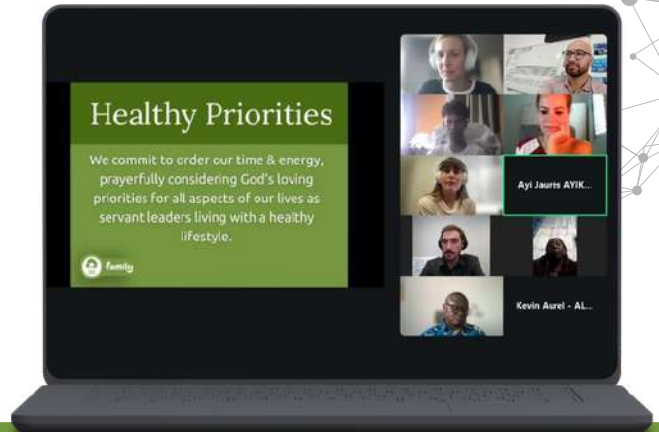
We're excited to have Nicolaas on the team and look forward to the role he will play in forming future ALICT participants and stewarding the programme's transformative impact.
